As retired law enforcement individuals we know that news reports cannot be trusted from cases we have been part of that made the news.

One of the latest issues of corruption is with the chief of IAD. Her niece was driving her car, along with her so-called boyfriend, and they were stopped by officers. Over 6,000 dollars' worth of drugs were thrown out of the car. All persons and the vehicle were transported to a police facility and, the driver was released with no tickets; the vehicle, which should have been confiscated and impounded, was returned and the arresting officers were re-assigned to desk duty while the car's owner, the CPD IAD head has been protected. Further, the male arrested was the CI in the wrong-address raid of Anjanette Young's house. She sued the city and several police officers and collected a \$2.9 million settlement of taxpayer's money. Not a thing was mentioned in the media, until after several other sources brought this incident to the attention of the public, and then only one TV news station decided to present the facts. Chicago Mayor Lightfoot was devoid of comment. The investigation was turned over to the Inspector General and they will get an answer in a few months. In reality, they hope everyone will forget about it by then. Again, who shall we believe?

Here's another issue. PPP (Payroll Protection Program) loans were made available to businesses during the shutdowns, and a majority of the loans were forgiven by the government. Well, it seems that there were a great number of fraudulent applications made, and one

company that I know of had over 100 of their employees making fraudulent applications. But guess what, the Chicago media reported a couple of Chicago Police Command personnel also made fraudulent applications. Did Mayor Lightfoot take any action? If she did, have you heard anything? Crickets.

More information has come to light regarding the November 2021 police exam. One hundred and fiftyfive people were called to take the written test; 59 showed up, and 30 of the 59 people failed the test leaving 29 in the running to become Chicago Police officers. From a previous list a "POWER TEST" was given. Four hundred applicants were invited to take the Power Test and 46 people showed up and only 4 passed. The Chicago Police Academy scheduled a new class of 50 people to start PPO training and 20 showed the first day. I received this information from a reliable source, however trying to get information from the city or department to confirm this without filing a FOIA is next to impossible. FOP stated that in 2021 over 1200 officers left the department. The Mayor and CPD just recently decided to lower education standards for police applicants. Instead of getting good candidates, we will be getting subpar officers. I wonder if this is being done on purpose.

How does this affect our pension that is already upside down with fewer paying in than are retired?

Driving, I'm sure that you have noticed a great increase in drivers who violate traffic laws. The posted speed limit on Chicago expressways is 55, yet average speeds are between 70 and 80 with bursts of 90 to 100 mph and that still does not outrun the bullets. The ISP has a limited number of cars doing expressway duty. The Dan Ryan only has two units patrolling from the loop to the Indiana border. However, if there is a shooting on an expressway the ISP can magically come up with several officers to look for shell casings. If the law is not going to be enforced why would people obey it? Engaging in pro-active policing today in Chicago and many other places is a fool's errand. Most Chicago officers keep a low profile to avoid trouble even if they are in the right. Why? They cannot depend on bosses or the department to back them up. Recently, an officer and his partner were shot. After saving the partner's life with a tourniquet and administering first aid to himself, COPA suggested giving the officer three days for not turning off the BWC!

We read and watch horrifying things taking place across the U.S., with people acting without fear of the consequences. Our so-called elected officials fear taking a stand because they do not want to alienate those who voted for them. We the people have to take a stand or we and our families are doomed.
