Director of the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund effective January 1, 2013. It must have been a difficult decision to accept a job where he has to relocate his family. I wish John and his family success and happiness. He will be missed.

The Illinois Veto Session will be on November 27-29 and December 4-6, 2012. I do not anticipate that there will be much business conducted in this year's veto session pertaining to pension issues because it takes a 2/3rd majority to make any changes. In the new legislative session of 2013, it only takes a majority of the vote to make any changes in pension legislation. On November 6, 2012, election day, there is a proposal on the ballot that is an attempt to impair or diminish our pension benefits. The proposed House Joint Resolution Constitutional Amendment 49 (HJRCA 49) is the first issue to be voted on the ballot. **Vote No on HJRCA 49!**




On Friday, November 2, 2012 at 9:00AM, I attended a Retiree Healthcare Benefit Commission meeting in the City Comptrollers conference room at 33 N. LaSalle Street. The Comptroller, Amer Ahmad, is the chairman of the commission. The meeting had standing room only with numerous Trustees, 3 Executive Directors, Attorneys, Union Representatives and City Officials. The commission is having bi-monthly meetings and the purpose of the meeting is to discuss the future of healthcare for retirees. The meeting lasted a little over one hour and the City presented numerous statistics pertaining to costs and healthcare plan options based on cost spectrums. There is another meeting scheduled for next Friday, November 9, 2012. I will keep the membership informed.

In another part of this newsletter there will be a membership renewal notice. Yes, it is that time of the year again. Please cut out the notice and return it with your 2013 dues check for \$15.00. If you received a letter in the past month telling you your dues are paid for 2013, do not send a check, you have already paid.

Due to unacceptable circumstances beyond my control you will be reading this very early. There are a lot of issues to be concerned with at the November elections. Locally, there is a proposed amendment to the Illinois State Constitution, which is HRJCA 49. Our state elected officials who are responsible for the poor financial condition our state and our pensions are in, are trying to take control of the pension issues. They screwed everything up in the first place and now they are saying they have to have control to fix the system. More lies. **VOTE NO FOR CA-49.**

After the November elections, stay alert for back door bills which our elected officials will try to sneak through. This will be especially important during the January veto sessions, where they will try to correct their mistakes on the backs of the tax payers.


